ABOUT ME

I am an urban professional and researcher working at the intersection of participatory urban governance, spatial justice, and translocal knowledge exchange. My expertise lies in co-governance and collaborative public infrastructure—exploring how policies, tools, and actors co-produce spatial justice from the ground up and across institutional layers.

Graduated in Architecture and Urbanism from the University of São Paulo (USP), I hold a Master's degree in Social Foundations of Contemporary Urbanism (USP, 2018), and am currently completing a PhD in Urban Studies at ISCTE – Lisbon and TU Wien, supported by a merit scholarship and an FCT grant. I have been recognised with a German Chancellor Fellowship by the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation and a Studentship from the IJURR Foundation, among other distinctions.

I co-founded The City Needs You Institute (Brazil), a reference in civic engagement and public space co-governance, and A GRUPA (Portugal), a European collective of female urban professionals applying feminist methodologies to urban practice. I authored the book *Doing it Together – Cooperation Tools for City Co-Governance*, published in English, Portuguese, and Spanish, and widely referenced in urban planning and participation contexts.

My methodological strengths include participatory action research, embedded ethnography, translocal peer learning facilitation, and the development of civic frameworks and democratic assessment tools. I have contributed to EU-funded initiatives such as URBiNAT, NBRACER, and SEALabHaus, and was deeply involved in URBACT's Com.Unity.Lab Transfer Network, both as researcher and practitioner.

I am particularly motivated to contribute through hybrid roles that bridge research, policy design, and civic practice—whether in EU cooperation programmes (URBACT, UIA, Horizon), international organisations (UN-Habitat, foundations), or postgraduate education. Recognised internationally as a speaker and facilitator, I have shared my work at events such as the Creative Bureaucracy Festival, WeMakeTheCity, and UN SDG launch at the UN Headquarters in New York, representing Brazilian civil society.

I thrive in collaborative, intellectually stimulating, and practice-oriented environments—committed to building possible and more just urban futures.
